MIPS Reporting for 2017 – It's Not Too Late!

Yes, it is November and, yes, it is getting close to the end of the first year of MACRA and MIPS. There is still time to report to ensure you don't get penalized 4% in 2019. Here are a few end of the year pointers:

- Please spend some time on the Quality Payment Program (QPP) website, (qualitypaymentprogram.cms.gov) that CMS has developed. It will help you with several things -
 - It will help you determine if you are exempt from reporting for this year. Remember, you are considered exempt from reporting if you had \$30,000 or less in Medicare Part B charges AND you had 100 or fewer Medicare patients. Enter your individual NPI number as directed.
 - If you are eligible, the QPP website can help you understand the minimum reporting requirements for 2017.
- Reach out to the Mountain Pacific Quality Health Foundation, <u>qualitypaymenthelp@mpqhf.org</u>, for assistance. MPQHF is a CMS partner in the quality payment program arena and they have expertise to help you directly.
- Visit the Rocky Mountain Health Network website (rmhn.org) for additional articles on MACRA.

And just one last reminder. If you are participating in the Medicare Shared Savings Plan, you don't need to submit any information for the Quality or Improving Care MIPS categories. You do, however, need to submit information on Advancing Care Information (aka meaningful use) if you have an Electronic Medical Record.

And as always, the team at RMHN is also here to assist with your MIPS and MACRA questions.
